NANO STROKE PATTERN PRACTICE – SECONDARIES & DETAILS

TIPS: First stroke typically starts at bottom border and is about half way or more tall in height. It can also be slightly off the bottom border for softer effect. It also is slightly bend and less straight than a squared front. The T1 stroke placement occurs when you've bent the previous primary strokes enough for it to fully bend. T1 could be the 4th stroke, the 6th stroke, etc. It's more so on getting the bend correct and when mapping T1 on a client, it needs to be where the natural brow is transitioning as well. Remember to keep primary's evenly spaced at the bottom but they can be wider at the top border.
