

## NANO STROKE PATTERN PRACTICE – ROUNDED FRONTS

TIPS: As with squared fronts, the T1 primary stroke does not have a designated number in brow meaning it could be the 3<sup>rd</sup>, the 6<sup>th</sup>, etc. You want T1 to be where brows naturally transition. The first primary stroke can begin above the border, in the middle of brow, or at the border. The goal is to have this hair curved and those following will be curved as well. The goal is to have them slightly curved, never completely curved giving the C appearance.
